Herbicide Orders

You can purchase two herbicides for timber stand improvement at our actual cost by contacting Fred Crouse, Consulting Forester, (fcrouse@centurytel.net) by Monday morning, May 16th. These products reflect actual prices at Van Diest Supply Company; tax is included:

✓ **Pathway** is \$105.37 per 2.5-gallon container or \$42.15 per gallon

○ A case is 2 – 2.5-gallon containers for \$210.74

✓ **Remedy Ultra** is \$68/gallon (2.5 gallons = \$170.00)

○ A case is 4 – 1-gallon containers for \$272.00

Note: Van Diest is not currently carrying Glyphosate, however, it is commonly sold at local farm supply stores. Watch the concentrations and pricing!
