# DIRECTIONS

**Pence Revington:** 12215 South 300 East; Brookston, IN 47923

From Brookston, head east on Hwy 18 for 2.9 miles to 300 E. Turn south (right) onto 300 East for 2.0 miles to 12215. Signs will be there to guide you to Pence's property. Turn east (left) through the double black gate and drive on the lane that takes you to the prairie planting (don't go up the hill). Once you have reached the prairie planting veer left and park near the steps to the cabin where we will meet up.

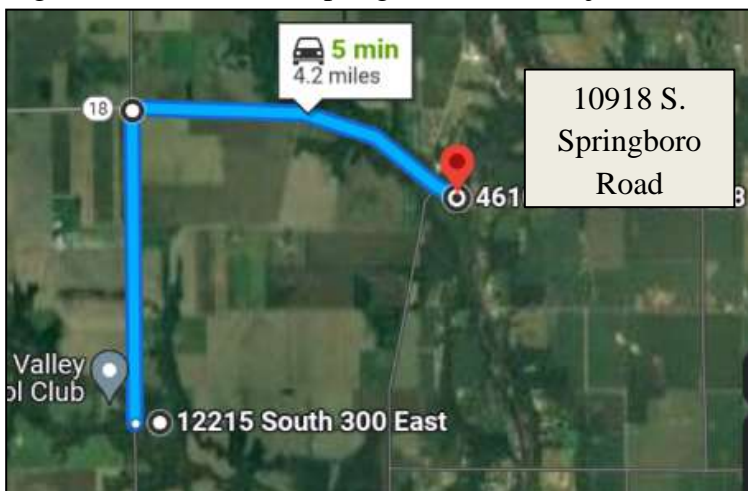


## Revington Woods



**Richard Hines:** 10918 S. Springboro Road, Brookston, IN 47923

From Pence's property turn north (right) onto 300 East and go 2.0 miles north back to Hwy 18 and turn east (right). Go 2.2 miles to Springboro Road and just before the bridge over the Tippecanoe River will be a public parking lot on the north side of the road. We will shuttle people up to the sugar-shack where the meeting begins and those interested can take a brisk hike uphill through the woods. The field tour is downhill and concludes near the parking lot.
