The Missouri Chapter, Walnut Council announces our fall forestry field day and business meeting **Saturday, October 29th, 2022, beginning at the Arrow Rock State Park Visitor Center.** This event is an opportunity to learn about and discuss woodland management topics with landowners, foresters, and industry representatives. Following a welcome, brief chapter business meeting and a slide presentation by Harlan Palm providing background information on our tour sites, we will travel first to the **Jack Crumbaugh** walnut plantation, then enjoy a box lunch at a historic site campground park shelter near Arrow Rock. Following lunch, we travel a short distance to the **Whitney Kerr** walnut plantation for our afternoon program.

Non-members and guests are welcome to attend. **We have applied for Category I SAF-CEU credits. Be certain to sign the attendance list at registration to secure CEUs.**

Attendees are encouraged to carpool to the farms from the Visitor Center. Both tree farms are a few miles west of Arrow Rock. It is unlikely there will be transportation available onsite at either location. Walking distances will be minimal.

The Visitor Center is located at: **39521 Visitor Center Drive, Arrow Rock, MO 65320**. It is a block-and-a-half south of Main Street in Arrow Rock. The **primary parking lot** entry road is located on Highway 41, one-quarter mile south of Arrow Rock. Watch for large historic site park signs.
